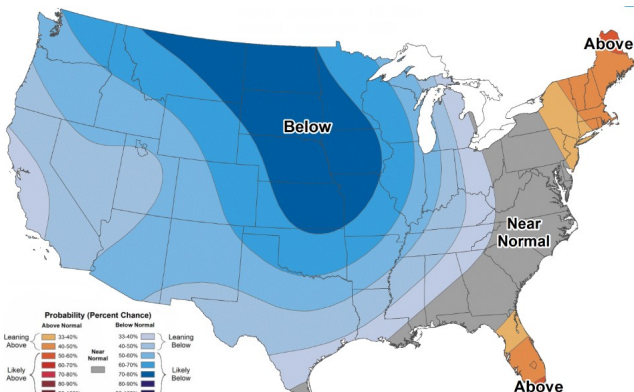
Futures Prices (NYMEX) through Jan 04, 2024

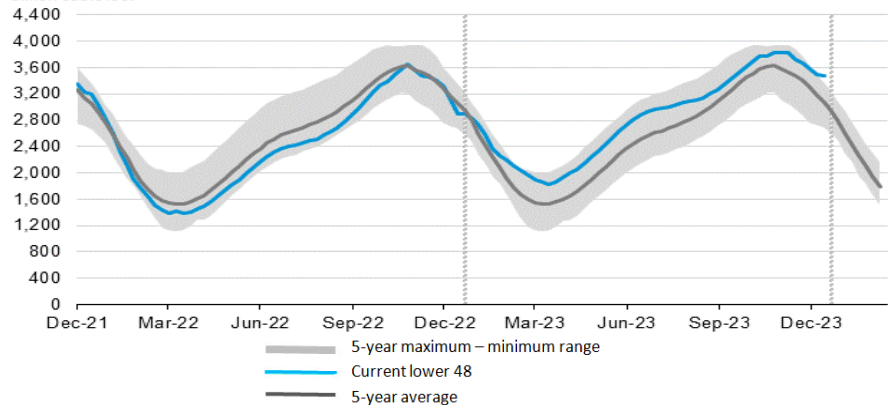

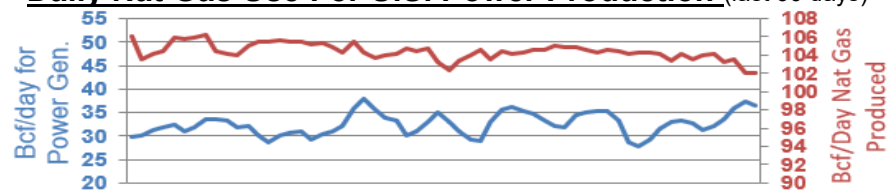
