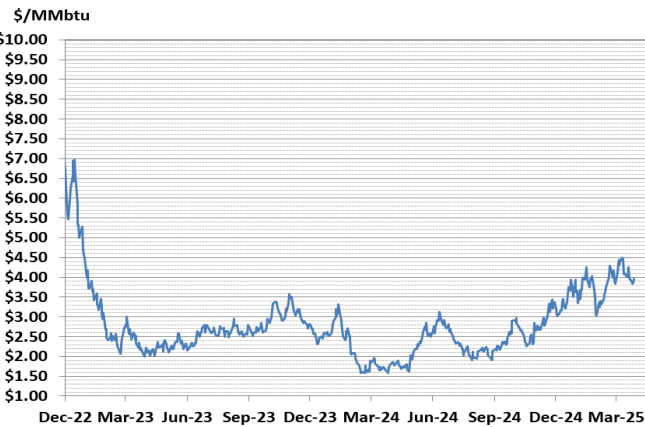

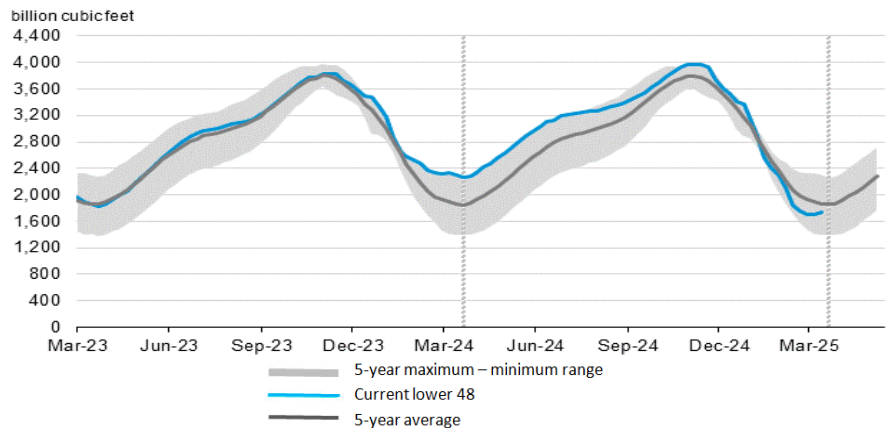

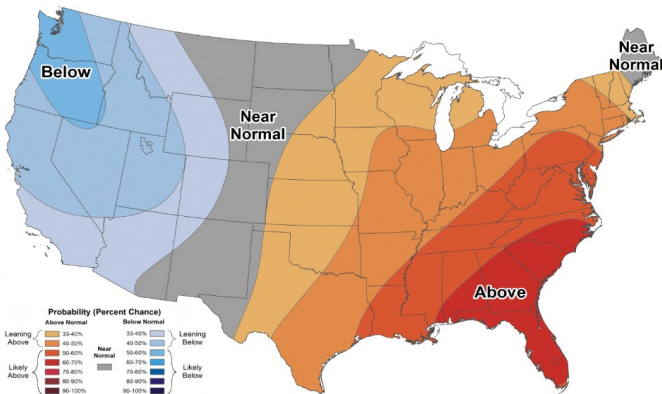

#### Working Gas in Storage Compared to 5-Year Range

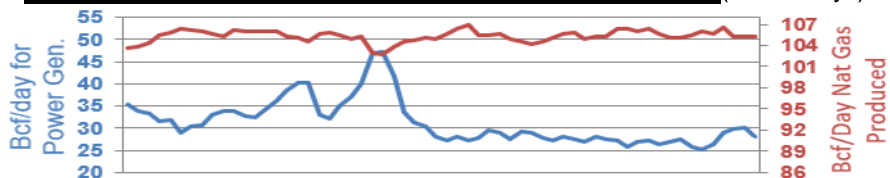


### Temperature Forecast
