Near- Month Natural Gas Futures Prices (NYMEX) through Sept 25, 2025





For the week ending Sep 19, 2025, natural gas storage reported by the Energy Information Administration (EIA) was as follows:



Working Gas in Storage Compared to 5-Year Range




Temperature Forecast Oct 03, 2025 through Oct 09, 2025
